






Washington County Chapter OGS

Early History Marietta, Ohio

On April 7, 1788 a band of 48 pioneers led by Revolutionary War General Rufus Putnam made the first lawful, organized American settlement within the limits of the great Northwest Territory. This settlement was Marietta. Washington County was formed that same year and covered nearly half of what is now Ohio.

A great number of the first pioneers were also veterans of the Revolutionary War. Thousands of settlers streamed into the state in the next years. Ohio's 1800 census reported 45,365 people. The state gained citizens so quickly that Washington County was reduced to its present boundaries by 1817. In 1820 the population had jumped to 581.434.
